Guzman: Pursuant to the status hearing and conference the court adopts the following procedure in general terms as the most efficient manner to move forward with this case. 1. within 30 days defendants shall enumerate the claims to which they object either in terms of a. calculation of the amount, b. the authority of the claimant to submit the claim, or c. some mechanical deficiency in the claim submission itself. 2.
